Mercy Kidz Haiti continues forward, working to impact the lives of children through education and the Gospel. In spite of ongoing challenges, the Mercy Kidz schools (all located in Northern Haiti) have remained open as much as possible. Due to political unrest and violence, there have been times when schools have been closed by the government, but fortunately in the North schools have been allowed to reopen. In a country where daily uncertainty and struggles are the norm, the opportunity to attend school, maintain a routine, and have daily encouragement of God's love and faithfulness, is vital for the children.

Looking ahead, one of Mercy Kidz biggest goals is to continue to improve communication and access to information for donors. This is no small undertaking! Creating a new database, transferring records accurately, having the ability to create necessary reports, and having everything in an easily understandable format creates a lot of moving parts. We continue to trust God to provide what is needed to accomplish the task. He is faithful and desires to see the children benefit.

In addition to this newsletter, donors will receive a report card later this year notifying them whether their student has passed their grade (or not). The report card will also provide other information about Mercy Kidz Haiti and update donors on the schools and Mercy Kidz in general.
